

# SUPPORT JIM BEAUMONT'S GREATEST CHALLENGE

We have named one of our races today the Support Jim Beaumont's Greatest Challenge At gofundme.com Handicap Chase to raise awareness for a GoFundMe page.

The Jim Beaumont in the race title is the son of Jim Beaumont the well-known racehorse owner who co-owned Aurora's Encore the winner of the 2013 Grand National at Aintree and who is a great supporter of racing in Scotland.

Jim jnr, a keen athlete and Iron Man competitor, was on a cycling training run when he was in a collison with a lorry and as a result had to have his right arm amputated above the elbow at the scene of the horrific crash.

His kidneys were so badly damaged in the collision he requires dialysis until a donor can be found. He was also in an induced coma for several weeks.

Jim is now recovering but will need specialist surgery and hopes to have a pioneering multifunctional prosthetic arm fitted.

Ironically Jim's job is chief clinician at the Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital in North London where he specialises in helping patients requiring prosthetic limbs and he hopes one day to resume his role there.

Such is Jim's determination to recover as well as possible from his injuries it is also his goal to return to competitive sport as a para-athlete.

For Jim to receive the specialist treatment and prosthetic arm his two sisters Lisa Beaumont and Nicky Buchanan have launched the GoFundMe page with the aim of raising £100,000 to fund the treatment which is not covered by the NHS.

Leading Scottish racehorse owner Ken McGarrity has been responsible for enlisting the help of Ayr, Kelso and Musselburgh racecourses in raising awareness of the fund and all three courses will have races named after the GoFundMe page starting with our Class 3 Handicap Chase today.
