

THE PERTEMPS NETWORK HANDICAP HURDLE (GRADE 3)

RACE DESCRIPTION This two and a half mile handicap hurdle is always a competitive contest and is one of the only intermediate trip Grade 3 handicap hurdles where runners are almost guaranteed to get good ground. Many trainers target this due to the favourable conditions, with novices holding a particularly strong record thanks to the lateness it is staged in the season. With a big field, horses with good tactical speed are able to excel over this two and a half mile trip.



Three Musketeers settled in well to life at Cullentra and made his first start for the yard a winning one. Returned to hurdles and down in trip on his stable debut, he travelled powerfully under Jack Kennedy to exploit his low hurdles mark of 132, having been rated as high as 155 over fences. Delivered late by Kennedy, the winner plugged on well to see off Tim Vaughan's Point Of Principle back in second and Canardier in third.

THE BETWAY TOP NOVICES' HURDLE (GRADE 1)

RACE DESCRIPTION The Top became a Grade 1 in 2016 and has been dominated by Nicky Henderson in recent years, with the likes Buveur D'Air, Josses Hill and My Tent Or Yours all those to have won from Seven Barrows. This race acts as a natural progression from the Supreme Novices' Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival, and the last horse to complete the Supreme-Top double was Browne's Gazette in 1984.



Fifth in the Supreme Novices' Hurdle, Felix Desjy came to Aintree full of confidence after that promising run and put his exuberant running style to use by making all in this race in 2019. Jack Kennedy was keen to be positive from the saddle and rode his mount into every hurdle, keen to keep momentum. A slight wobble up the run-in was soon corrected, and he stayed on well to see off the fast finishing Aramon in second.

THE BETWAY MILDMAY NOVICES' CHASE (GRADE 1)

RACE DESCRIPTION Named after the course the race is ran on, the Mildmay, this contest was first ran in 1981. A race for those who contested the Brown Advisory Novices' Chase (the Broadway) at the Cheltenham Festival, this test is ideal for those three mile chasers looking to gain more experience before taking the step into open company next season. First ran as a Grade 1 in 2014, Might Bite is the last horse to complete the Cheltenham-Aintree double.



Despite being keen throughout the race, Colin Tizzard's Lostintranslation put RSA winner Topofthegame in his place rather easily thanks to a superb round of jumping. Robbie Power enabled his mount to jump fluently throughout and had plenty of horse underneath him over the final two fences, with Lostintranslation easing away to win by a widening six lengths. RSA winner Topofthegame snatched second in the shadow of the post from Top Ville Ben.

EACH-WAY BETTING TERMS

Working alongside the Racecourse Association (RCA), bookmakers have introduced standard each-way betting terms across Jockey Club Racecourses. Bookmakers will provide these terms, or better, when offering each-way betting.

- Fewer than 3 runners: win bets only, no places offered
- 3 or 4 runners: all to win. Where a bookmaker wishes to depart from this default position he may offer place terms for 3 or 4 runners, this must be at 1/5 odds a place 1-2
- 5 to 7 runners (inclusive): 1/4 (one quarter) odds for finishing 1st or 2nd
- 8 or more runners: 1/5 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd
- Handicap races with 12 to 15 runners (inclusive): 1/4 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd
- Handicap races with 16 to 21 runners (inclusive): 1/5 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th
- Handicap races with 22 or more runners: 1/4 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th

THE MARSH STEEPLE CHASE (REGISTERED AS THE MELLING CHASE) (GRADE 1)

RACE DESCRIPTION Another Grade 1 with a rich history, the Marsh Melling Chase was added to the racing calendar in 1991, with Grade 1 status handed for it's inaugural running. Named after the nearby village of Melling, situated on the famous Melling Road which crosses the racecourse, this is for many the feature race of the meeting. Another event over the intermediate trip of two miles and four furlongs, the likes of Don Cossack, Finian's Rainbow and Sprinter Sacre feature on the roll of honour.



Min was at his imperious best when winning this in 2019, making all the running and putting in an exhibition round of jumping under Ruby Walsh. His victory was the most in command that many have seen for a long while in such a high-profile Grade 1, and he won unchallenged in mighty style. He bounced back from a below-par run at Cheltenham and put his rivals to the sword winning easily by 20 lengths.

THE RANDOX TOPHAM HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (GRADE 3)

RACE DESCRIPTION The second of three races run over the famous Grand National fences, the Topham is staged over almost half the distance of the Randox Grand National. Always Waining landed his race for three successive years from 2010 to 2013, with Ultragold winning back to back renewals in 2017 and 2018. This race is always a tough ask, so it's not a surprise to see that horses with plenty of previous experience over the fences fare the best in this Grade 3 handicap.



Making all the running, Cadmium ran out a most impressive winner of the 209 Topham, excelling on his first run over the Grand National fences. Paul Townend allowed his mount to find a smooth jumping rhythm and the pair came clea unchallenged.
