CUSTOMER CODE OF CONDUCT

DISABLED FACILITIES



Haydock Park has made substantial practical changes to our facilities to ensure we follow all mandatory disability requirements, which include the following:

- Inclusion of induction loops installed in suites and bars
- Braille being included on the majority of our signage
- Improvements to disabled viewing areas
- Suite doors being widened
- Lowering of betting facilities to improve access
- Viewing balconies improved for wheelchair access
- The introduction of a disabled lift
- Changes to existing lifts to allow wheelchair operation
- Increasing disabled car parking access
- Widening car parking spaces and installing appropriate signage
- Additional centrally located disabled toilets
- Modification of existing toilets to allow ambulant disabled access (including widening cubicles, installation of grab rails, lengthening mirrors, adjusting flush mechanisms, adjustments to door locking facilities and washbasin and handles)
- Refuge areas constructed in case of fire (including the installation of a 2-way communication system with the on-site control room to each point)
- Additional Evac chairs
- Changes to health and safety procedures to protect disabled persons
- Changes in admissions policy in respect of disabled persons (ie, allowing carers in free of charge)

HOW TO PLACE A BET WITH A RACECOURSE BOOKMAKER

WAYS TO BET

WIN ONLY: The most common form of bet. You win if your horse is first past the post. Example: £5 win at 8/1 would return £45 ($8 \times £5 = £40 + £5$ stake).

EACH WAY: Backing a horse to win or be placed. This doubles your bet – for example: £5 each way = £5 to win and £5 for a place = £10 total stake.

STANDARD EACH WAY TERMS

In conjunction with The RCA, the bookmakers have introduced standard each-way terms. Bookmakers will provide these terms, or better, when offering each-way betting.

- Fewer than 4 runners – all on to win
- 5 – 7 runners (inclusive) – 1/4 odds a place 1,2
- 8 or more runners – 1/5 odds a place 1,2,3
- Handicaps with 12 to 15 runners (inclusive) – 1/4 odds a place 1,2,3
- Handicaps with 16 to 21 runners (inclusive) – 1/5 odds a place 1,2,3,4
- Handicaps with 22 or more runners – 1/4 odds a place 1,2,3,4

Some bookmakers also offer 'betting without the favourite', where you can back your selection at reduced odds to either win or finish second to the horse nominated by the bookmakers as favourite. You may bet with confidence with any bookmaker on course as they operate with Administration Of Gambling On Tracks Ltd. (AGT) approval. In the unlikely event of a dispute with a bookmaker, please call upon the assistance of the AGT Betting Ring Manager, who can be found on the ground floor of the Grandstand Enclosure. The AGT also offers a 'late pay' service in case the bookmaker leaves the course before you have collected your winnings. Late pay claims should be sent to: AGT, 3A Kings Hall, Parsons Green, St Ives, Cambridgeshire, PE27 4WY.

PLACING A BET

Experiencing the buzz of the betting ring may be a little daunting at first, but you will soon find it is very easy to place a bet. Here are some guidelines for racegoers to follow:

1. Each bookmaker will be offering slightly different prices, so shop around for the best odds against your selection.
2. Call your bet clearly to the bookmaker by stating the name and/or number of your chosen horse and the stake.
3. Listen to the bookmaker repeat your bet to his/her clerk and correct him immediately if any details are called wrongly.
4. Make sure you obtain a ticket from the bookmaker and keep it safe.
5. If your selections wins, hand the ticket back to the bookmaker for settlement. Never destroy or dispose of your ticket until after the "Weighed in" announcement has been made. Betting with the bookmaker is tax-free. Deductions are made only if a horse is withdrawn after the betting market has been formed.

Please check the minimum stake accepted by each bookmaker on his display board. Some bookmakers do not take sums under £5, especially in the main betting ring, but there will be others who are happy to accept £2 bets. Please tender the correct change when possible.

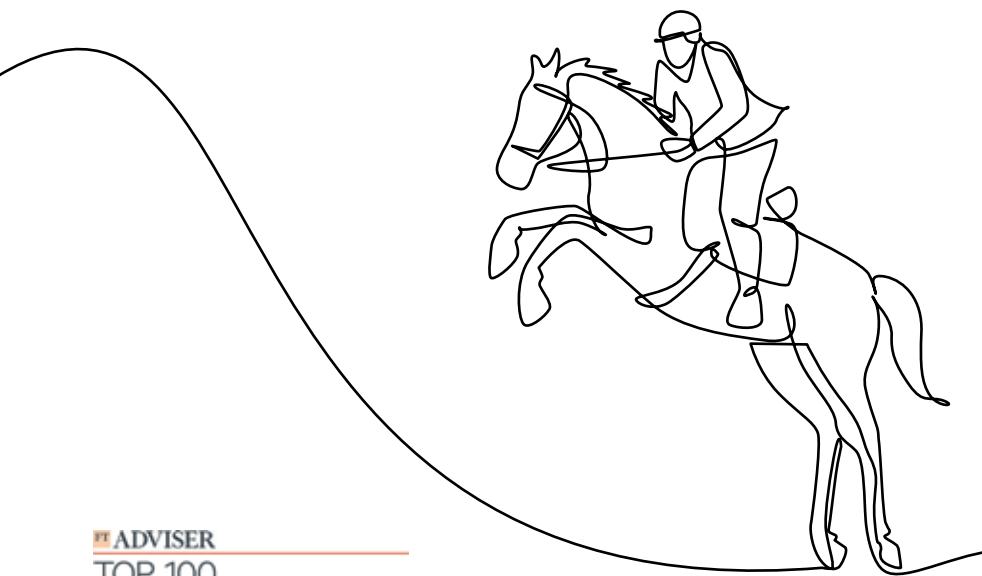

You won't find many horses in history with a better record at Haydock Park than Bristol De Mai, who will bid to equal the great Kauto Star's tally of four Betfair Chase victories this afternoon. With history at stake, Nick Seddon takes a closer look at the much-loved grey horse.

It didn't take long for Bristol De Mai to make an impression on his trainer Nigel Twiston-Davies, who explained during his media duties on Zoom earlier in the week that he knew he had a special horse on his hands as soon as his British debut – when he watched his charge make the perfect start by winning the Grade One Finale Juvenile Hurdle at Chepstow by six lengths in December, 2014.

Recording a top-level victory on your first start on these shores is a feat that very few indeed achieve, though it would be over fences where the son of Saddler Maker would come into his own. After a strong start to his novice chasing campaign he gave a sign of what was to come at this very course, winning the 2016 Grade Two Altcar Novices' Chase by some 32 lengths in heavy going.

Testing conditions aren't mandatory for Bristol De Mai to shine of course, but he certainly became known for being devastatingly effective when others were crying enough and another wide margin victory would follow here the following season, by 22 lengths in the 2017 renewal of the Grade Two Peter Marsh Chase.

The grey would fall short at the top level that spring, finishing seventh in the Cheltenham Gold Cup and fifth in the Aintree Bowl, but he returned the following season as an improved model and victory in the Charlie Hall Chase at Wetherby was a signal of what was to come. Bristol De Mai had won at the top level as a novice, but it was the 2017 Betfair Chase in which he made his breakthrough in open company, sauntering to a 57-length success over no less than a three-time Betfair Chase winner in Cue Card in testing conditions.

Winning by such a wide margin at this lofty level is rarely seen and it was at this point that his 'King of Haydock' moniker was born. Bristol De Mai was a name to be feared on Merseyside and he would defend his title in some style 12 months later, defeating a stellar field of five which consisted of Native River, Thistlecrack, Clan Des Obeaux and Might Bite by four lengths.

A straightforward type, Twiston-Davies explained earlier in the week that the secret to the grey's success is his ability to dominated proceedings in uncomplicated circumstances, with two long straights and easy bends. It meant that he received criticism from some onlookers for being a one course specialist, but his effort to finish a fine third in the 2019 Cheltenham Gold Cup defied that and showed there is certainly substance to the fact he's considered to be a top-class staying chaser.

Bristol De Mai would suffer his first and only defeat at Haydock Park later that year and a one and a half-length defeat felt like a changing of the guard, with the then eight year old passing the baton to the exciting new kid on the block, Lostintranslation of the Colin Tizzard team, in the 2019 Betfair Chase. It would later transpire that Bristol De Mai had struggled with lameness issues in the build-up and he would roar back 12 months later, turning the tables on Lostintranslation and holding off the attentions of the Sam Twiston-Davies ridden Clan Des Obeaux to equal Cue Card's tally of three wins in the race.

Still only a 10 year old, there ought to be a few miles left in the admirable grey's tank just yet and when speaking earlier in the week, his trainer pointed out that his straightforward nature could give him an advantage on the challengers.

He said: "The race looks as hot as ever really, but the one thing he always has in his favour is that he's so easy to get fit and I wonder whether they all will be as fit as he is – hopefully not. It's great to see an Irish challenger too, it's great for the race and hopefully we can beat everyone."

If anyone can, it's the King of Haydock Park.

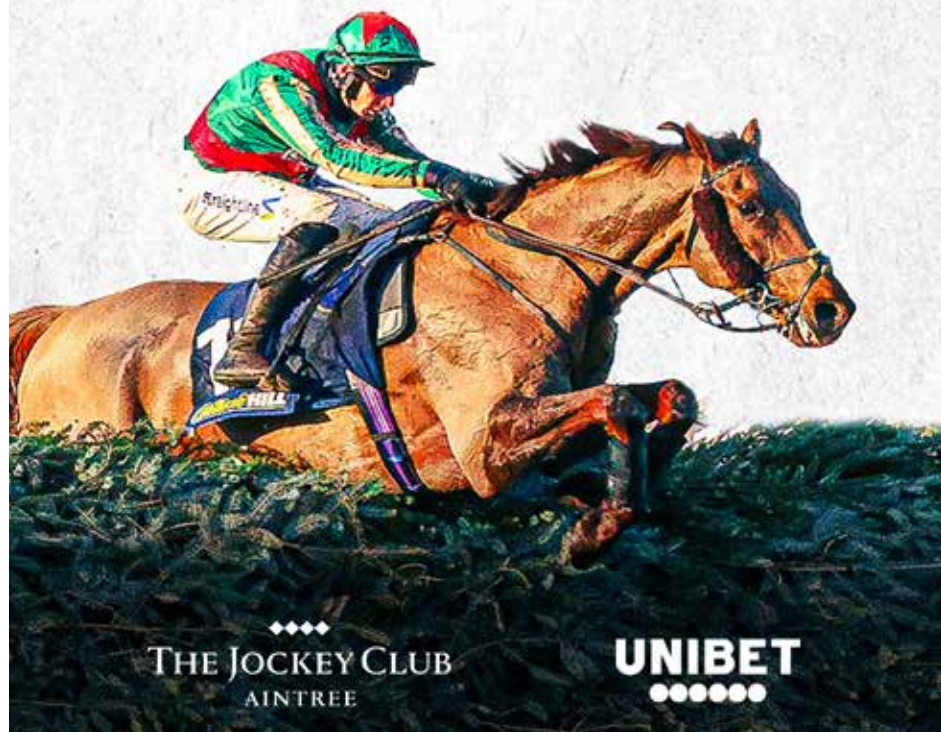

We have agreed with our vets that the screen should be erected, whenever a horse requires veterinary treatment on the course. This does not reflect the severity of an injury, but does help to provide a calm environment, in which the vet is better able to treat the horse.

Please do not assume the worst if you see screens erected around a fallen horse.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO RACECOURSE

Management reserves the right to refuse admission to, or eject from, the racecourse any person without assigning a reason. In particular, any instance of unruly behaviour, such as drunkenness, abusive conduct, singing or shouting, shall entitle the Racecourse Executive to expel the offending racegoer without prior notice.

Racegoers must abide by any regulations including the observance of designated non-drinking areas and standards of dress. Premier Enclosure - tie and smart trousers (no jeans) for gentlemen and best day wear for ladies. County Enclosure smart dress for both ladies and gentlemen is advised. Fancy dress, sportswear (including training shoes) or swimwear are not permitted. Grandstand & Paddock & Be Friendly Enclosures no dress code. Fancy dress is permitted but please make sure your outfit is not offensive to others.

Only individuals in possession of a valid betting badge and occupying an authorised pitch are entitled to lay bets in the course of their business. Any individuals found contravening these conditions will be evicted. Members of the public may not use two-way radios, scanning receivers etc, for any purpose at the racecourse.

ABANDONMENT

In the event of abandonment before racing, or up to the 'Weighed-in' of the first race, there will be a full refund of badge, ticket and car parking costs. In the event of abandonment after the 'Weighed-in' of the first race, up to the 'Weighed-in' of the third race there will be a 50% refund of the badge and car parking costs. In the event of abandonment thereafter there will be no refunds. No cash refunds to be paid on the day.
